WORD IN DEED MINISTRIES - FIVE YEAR PLAN

Resource Center

*5 acres of land already purchased by WID. Center will serve as main headquarters w. office space, meeting/ training facilities and housing for approx. 30 individuals. Housing will generate income (self sustain).

Year One: Construction of Resource Center. Will bring outside contractors (eMI partnership) but hire and train local villagers in order to provide jobs.

Hire administrator to oversee project. Hire local employees so they are in place once Resource Center is completed.

Complete need assessment for school needs in the 6 villages to include local teachers available, existing Ugandan curriculum, social responsibility (civic education) ... what does this look like?

Design curriculum and training materials to further enhance education.

Design and distrubute training materials for agriculture/farming, vocational training like carpentry, sewing, etc.
Partnership with other non-profits, i.e. Uganda Water
Project, Water With Blessings (Water Woman Project)
and Farming God's Way.

School (Ntanzi Primary)

School building in place and current enrollment is approx. 300 students. Need construction of dormitories, additional latrines and soccer field.

Year One: Construction of dormitories, latrines and soccer field.

Villages of Mpatta and Bunakijja

Year Two: Construction of two schools by local villagers (already trained) with supervision of outside contractor.

Hire for each school -Head Mistress, 12 teachers and 2 deputies.

Train teachers in best practices, social responsibility and trade techniques.

Training of locals in agriculture/ farming, etc.

Year Three: Construction of two schools by local villagers.

Hire for each school: Head Mistress, 12 teachers and 2 deputies.

Villages of Banga and Ssozi

Train new teachers in best practices, social responsibility and trade techniques. Ongoing assessment.

Training of locals in new school villages in agriculture/farming, etc. Host Palm Beach Atlantic Pharmacy School students and missionaries.

School (Mpunge Primary)

This school is completed with dormitories for students and teachers, farming grounds and soccer field. All new schools will follow the same construction model as this one.

Current needs are new generator and solar lighting system for boarding students and teachers to function and study in evening hours (no electric in this village).

Year One: Installation of solar lighting system.

Year Four and Year Five: Continuted training for all teachers in all 6 schools. Evaluation of Program for continued sustainability and independent management and administraion. Continued community outreach, educational seminars, facilitation of short term mission trips (PBAU, etc).
